



In strong direct sunlight the Solar Panel on the front of the Water Controller is able to power the device and recharge the batteries






Connect the Gateway to a USB Power Adapter using a Micro USB Cable.

#### **TROUBLESHOOTING**

- 1. The Water Controller is not Connecting to App
- The Water Controller needs the Gateway to work.
  The Gateway needs to be connected to the App first then the Water Controller to the Gateway.
- Please check your Wifi username and password are correct and you are only using 2.4Ghz Wifi connections as the 5Ghz band is not supported.
- The Solar Panel is not Working or the Water Controller has no Power
- The Water Controller needs 2 x AA batteries to work.
- If you want the Solar Panel to recharge the battery then 2 x AA rechargeable batteries need to be installed.
- The Solar Panel can recharge the batteries approx
  2 5% every couple of hours with strong direct sunlight.
